Academic Results

The entire success was the result of the dedicated efforts of the management, principal, teaching and non teaching staff and the student community. Participation in the National Science Olympiad, itself is the biggest competition where a student competes to outshine

others. Many students got gold, silver and bronze medals and 5 students got eligibility to participate in the Second Level.

Staff Enrichment Programmes
